- Luke 13:22 And he went through the cities and villages, teaching, and journeying toward Jerusalem.
- Luke 13:23 Then said one unto him, Lord, are there few that be saved? And he said unto them,
- Luke 13:24 Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able.
- Luke 13:25 When once the master of the house is risen up, and hath shut to the door, and ye begin to stand without, and to knock at the door, saying, Lord, Lord, open unto us; and he shall answer and say unto you, I know you not whence ye are:
- Luke 13:26 Then shall ye begin to say, We have eaten and drunk in thy presence, and thou hast taught in our streets.
- Luke 13:27 But he shall say, I tell you, I know you not whence ye are; depart from me, all ye workers of iniquity.
- Luke 13:28 There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of God, and you yourselves thrust out.
- Luke 13:29 And they shall come from the east, and *from* the west, and from the north, and *from* the south, and shall sit down in the kingdom of God.
- Luke 13:30 And, behold, there are last which shall be first, and there are first which shall be last.

As we read this to you tonight, this portion of scripture... A week or two ago, I'm not sure exactly when it was but we talked about Zacchaeus and we talked about Bartimaeus. The tax collector that was at Jericho and also Bartimaeus sat outside the city of Jericho; this is on the same trip. These events are happening at the same time...as those events were happening.

When I read to you here that he goes through—in verse 22—the cities and the villages teaching and journeying towards Jerusalem. That is what He was doing. He was going towards Jerusalem. He was going that way. As I said then, He was never again going to come on this journey this way again. He was never ever going to come through the city of Jericho, and the other little cities, towns and villages that He was going to go through as He was headed towards Jerusalem. He was going to go to Jerusalem. When He was here on earth, He was never going to visit them again.

I think there is a great lesson in that for you and me. I think that opportunities in life are something we need to take advantage of every day. Do you know what? The opportunities that I have today, they may not be there tomorrow. The opportunities that

you have today, to talk to your family or do something that is going to bring glory to God; you may not have them tomorrow because you may not be here tomorrow. Those that you could witness to, or those that you could talk to; they may not be here tomorrow. Do you know what we need to do? Every opportunity that we have that God allows us and blesses us to do something that is going to bring glory to His name, do you know what we need to do? We need to do it the very best that we can. Do you know what I know? I know when we will do that God will bless us to be a blessing to other people. I know that we will see some people saved along the way. We can be a blessing to some people.

No. Not all of my family is probably not going to get saved and all your family is not going to get saved. Do you know what I am not going to do? I am not going to quit just because some of my family decided they are not going to follow Jesus Christ; I am going to continue on. I know there are people on every street, every town; there are people that needs and wants to get saved. Do you know what you and I should be doing? We should be searching for those people. We should be looking for them. Again, there is coming a day that opportunity is going to cease. Not only that but also, for you that are unsaved here tonight, if you are here and unsaved, or if you are listening to me around the world; I want you to understand that the opportunity that you have to get saved... There is coming a day that the opportunity for you to get saved it is going to be gone. It may be today. I don't know.

The Bible says here...

Luke 13:22 And he went through the cities and villages, teaching, and journeying toward Jerusalem.

Luke 13:23 Then said one unto him, Lord, are there few that be saved? And he said unto them,

As He is traveling, going towards Jerusalem, teaching and preaching in different cities, villages, and towns; the Bible says here in verse 23 there was a fellow that came to Him and said, "Hey, you have been talking about being saved and being born again and getting ready to go to heaven and repenting of sins, and becoming disciples, and denying our self, taking up the cross and following you. You have been talking about all this stuff that we need to do." So, he begins to ask a question. The Bible says here, "Are there few that is going to be saved?"

Luke 13:23 Then said one unto him, Lord, are there few that be saved? And he said unto them,

That was a pretty good question that he asked. He was wondering how many people are really going to get saved. If you do much reading from theologians and different people that will be a question that you will read and come across at different times. How many people are really going to be in heaven? I am going to give you some insight tonight. Write this down. I don't have a clue and nobody else does either.

Listen. That is way over my head. I do know there are going to be people there.

But this guy has a question. How many people are going to be saved? Are there just a few people going to be saved? There is no doubt in my mind, that he is asking this question, he is wondering in his mind, if I have to take up a cross and follow Him, if I have to forsake all and follow Him, if I have to sell all that I have and give it to the poor and come and follow Him then there couldn't be very many people saved.

Listen. Jesus was a very misunderstood fellow. When He was here and even the gospel message today, it can get confusing to a lot of people. What I want you to understand is it is really not confusing at all. Jesus Christ came, suffered, bled and died at Calvary to...save, to rescue your soul from a lake of fire. If you will just say yes to Jesus Christ, I believe that You died. I believe that You rose from the dead. I know that You did all of this to save me from a lake of fire. Do you know what He will do? He will save you. He will change your life. He will put you on the road to heaven. Do you know what you will find out? That a lot of things that you have heard preached and taught, maybe, are not true at all.

That is why I want you to read your Bible. I say this a lot. I want you to read your Bible. When you read your Bible, you won't be misled. You will know what is in there. When people, some preacher, some pastor, some teacher teaches something that is not right; you will know that when you read the Bible.

Here is the question. Are there going to be a few people that are going to heaven? Do you know what? Look what Jesus does here? He did not answer his question. He is going to bring it down on a personal level for this guy. This guy had a question how many are going to be in heaven or are there just going to be a few in heaven. Jesus made the statement in verse 24.

Luke 13:24 Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able.

Look what Jesus is saying. He is talking to this individual here. He is going to remind him. He is going to tell him. He is going to put him in a place that he needs to think about where he is at, whether he is on his way or whether he is not on his way.

That is what we need to do today. We don't need to wonder how many people are going to be in heaven. Do you know what we need to make sure of today? We need to make sure that we are going to be in heaven. We need to make sure today that our sins have been forgiven. We need to make sure today, that we are on the way.

That is what Jesus is saying here. He says *strive*. The Greek word means agonize. It means with struggle. Listen. There is going to have to be some self-denial if we are going to get into the kingdom of God. We are going to have to say No to some stuff. We are going to have to say Yes to the Lord's will and No to our will. We are going to have to live in a way that we are going to deny our self and take up His cross and we are going to follow Him.

I'm glad today, even though the way sometimes, there is agony. We must agonize with Almighty God about different things. I'm so very glad that we can know that our sins are forgiven and that we are on our way to heaven. That is great to know.

Strive, He says. To enter in at the straight gate. Strive, agonize, struggle. Listen. It is a struggle for people. It is not a struggle to be saved. It is a struggle sometimes for people to get where they can be saved. There is a difference there. In life a lot of times, it is hard for people to give up stuff. There are people that have sat in the pews at different times here at Campbell Chapel that God has stirred their hearts in different places, that God has stirred their hearts. God has convicted them of their sin. They have stood. They have cried. I have seen the tears run down their eyes. I have met them at the back door. I have talked to them at the back door. Preacher, I needed to get saved. I should have gone forward tonight. However, when you talk to them just a little bit do you know what you will find out? There is something in their life that they don't want to give up. It may be a job. It may be positions. It may be money. It may be some friendships of people they think that they can't replace them. If we are going to get saved, we have to deny ourselves. We are going to have to come to the place that we realize that the only thing in life that really matters is if I am ready to meet God.

Listen. You can't hold God in one hand and hold the world in the other hand and expect to go to heaven. It is not going to go that way. Sometimes it is a struggle to lay it all down. Sometimes people has a struggle about laying down alcohol and drugs. They think they can't do that. Sometimes they don't want to do that. They don't want to give up their lifestyle that they are living. They think that how they are living is more important than living for Jesus.

Listen to me tonight. The greatest thing you will ever do is the day that you give your life to Jesus Christ. The greatest thing that will ever happen to you is when the Holy Ghost moves in. He takes the devil that is setting up in your heart and on the throne of your heart. He casts him out. When He comes in your life and sits upon your heart will be the greatest day of your life. Even a greater day than when you married her, or you married her... Those are all great days, but the greatest day is when Jesus Christ moves in. Nothing can compare to that. The struggle.

There is pleasure in sin for a season. People have struggles. Preacher I like what I am doing. Preacher I'm not too bad. Preacher I have never done a lot of things that a lot of people do. I don't do this. I don't do that. I pay my bills. I go to church. I participate in religious things. We are going to get there in a minute. I do all of that preacher. I'm not a bad person. You know, Jesus did not come to save bad people. He came to save lost people. Amen! You can be the greatest guy in the world and still be lost. Amen! You can be the greatest neighbor in the world and still be lost. You can be the greatest boss, the greatest husband or wife; you can be the greatest dad in the world and still yet be lost. Amen!

He says here strive, agonize. Listen. In life, I can remember my own self. If you are saved here tonight, you can remember how it was when God was speaking to you. You understood, hey. You began to think, what are my friends going to say? That was a big deal for me. These guys that I had loafed with, drank with, and run with, played ball with, drag raced with; that was a big thing to me. What are they going to think about me? I'm going to lose them as friends then I won't have any friends. I am not going to enjoy life. There is nothing to do if you get saved, that you can enjoy. However, listen, that was lie right straight out of hell. Because the night that I gave my heart to the Lord there were some people that did not want to be my friend anymore. Do you know I did and what happened? I was born into the family of the king of kings and Lord of lords. Listen.

The God of heaven has all kinds of sons and daughters everywhere across this world. They all became my friends on the night I got saved. I may not ever meet some of them here but there is going to be a day that we are going to meet all of our friends that has gone on before us, that may go with us. Thank God, when Jesus Christ moves in then we can really have people that we can call friends. That was a big deal for me.

You have to quit this, can't go here, can't do that. That is true. I had to do some of that stuff. It is a struggle. I came to the point in life that I said, hey, I have had enough. All this stuff does not outweigh my eternal soul. All the friendships that are here, all the fun we may have been having running up and down the road and all the stuff we were doing; it did not outweigh the eternity of my soul.

Do you know what I figured out? I figured out, it took a pretty good while for me to do this and with the Lord's help I figured out, if I don't have Jesus Christ then I don't have anything. I had a brand new Chevelle sitting in the yard. Had a motorcycle sitting out there. We hadn't been married very long. Had a construction job. Had a lot of things going on. However, do you know what I figured out? I figured out I needed something more than all of that. I need something more than all of that. I needed Jesus Christ. He saved my soul.

The Bible says here...

Luke 13:24 Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able.

Get this. The strait gate, do you know what that means? That means narrow. Not only that but it means there is only one gate here.

I thought about today as I was thinking about this. If you have ever gone to a NASCAR race, or a football game at some of these places at some of the colleges or a basket ball game; they have all kinds of doors. All the way around the theatres, or all the way around the stadium, there are all kinds of doors that you can enter in at. As you go in this gate or that gate...it is depending on where you are parking at.

However, if you are going to go to heaven there is only one gate. There is only one way. There is only one door to get there, friend. Listen. His name is Jesus Christ. He is not one of many ways. He is the only way. He is the only door. He is the only avenue that you can get from this life unto heaven.

Listen. He said...

Luke 13:24 Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able.

Do you know why Jesus made that statement? Do you know why people are not going to be able to go? It is not because He doesn't love them. It is not because His blood is lacking something. The reason people are not going to go to heaven is because they don't want to deny themselves.

They don't want to pick up the cross of Jesus Christ and follow Him. Their lifestyle and what they are doing; they love it. They love sin. They love where they are at. Listen. I'm going to read it to here again. There is coming a day that your mindset is going to change. There is coming a day, that your thought process is going to change. The sad part about it is it is going to be too late. Amen!

Luke 13:25 When once the master of the house is risen up, and hath shut to the door, and ye begin to stand without, and to knock at the door, saying, Lord, Lord, open unto us; and he shall answer and say unto you, I know you not whence ye are:

Opportunities for people to be saved, just like there are opportunities for you and me to minister to people that are saved, to minister and do things for God; the opportunity for people to get saved is going to come to an end one day. I don't know when your opportunity that you have, that has been afforded you today and down through life; I don't know when that is going to come to an end. I do know that there is coming a day that the opportunity for mankind and individuals to get saved; I know it is going to come to an end.

I have seen many times, over the years of ministry, we have seen people that have come to church and sat in pews and did all kinds of things but they let that opportunity slip through their fingers. You get a call sometime in the middle of the night or early of the morning or in the middle of the day; hey, so and so is gone. He has died.

Listen. When you die the opportunity that you have to be saved is gone. There is not going to be an opportunity on the other side of the grave for you to be saved. Listen. Today is the day of salvation, if you hear His voice harden not your heart. There is going to come a time that God will not be speaking to you anymore. There is going to be a time that they are going to fold your hands. Some funeral director somewhere; they are going to take your shoes off. They may change you. They may wash your body. They may put you on a new suit. They may comb your hair. However, the opportunity that you have had to be saved is going to be gone. You don't get saved in

the casket. You don't get saved in the grave. You will not get saved when you are in the lake of fire. There is no opportunity there.

That is what Jesus wants this guy to understand. Don't let the opportunity slip you by. He is saying here strive to enter in at the strait gate. He says because the master is going to raise up one day. He is going to go to the door and He is going to close it. Does everybody believe that? You should believe that. There is coming a day when the opportunity for people to be saved is going to be over.

I can remember thinking that when I was unsaved. I can remember sitting and thinking how awful it would be for me to miss going to heaven. How awful that would have been. Now when the Lord first started to convict me I didn't think that. I liked what I was doing. It was fun. The longer I weighed out the situation, I came to figure out that it wasn't worth it.

The Bible says...

Luke 13:25 When once the master of the house is risen up, and hath shut to the door, and ye begin to stand without, and to knock at the door, saying, Lord, Lord, open unto us; and he shall answer and say unto you, I know you not whence ye are:

The master is going to raise up. When that time is I don't know. No doubt, He is speaking to us in a parable here something we can look at and understand some spiritual things that He is talking about, but the door is going to be closed.

I can read in the scriptures...when God warned Noah about a flood and He warned him and told him that he needed to build a boat. Do you know what Noah did? He builds a boat. He gets his family inside. God sends the animals inside. However, there came a day that God shut up the side of the boat of the ark. God shut it up. There was no other way to get in the ark except that one door and God shut it up.

The opportunity for people to get saved is going to come to an end. The Bible says He raises up and He shuts the door. The Bible says here...

Luke 13:25 When once the master of the house is risen up, and hath shut to the door, and ye begin to stand without, and to knock at the door, saying, Lord, Lord, open unto us; and he shall answer and say unto you, I know you not whence ye are:

Listen. There is going to come a day that you are going to be beating, knocking and praying. There is going to come a day—whether you believe this or not—the Bible says that every knee shall bow and every tongue shall confess that Jesus Christ is the Lord to the glory of God the Father. There is going to be a lot of people that are going to die lost. Yet, one day there are going to have to recognize that Jesus Christ is the Lord.

Do you know what I would beg you to do? I would plead with you to get saved today and declare His name today and accept Him today, because it is not going to do you

any good on the other side of the grave to declare Him being the Lord. It won't help you none.

You might say why would He do that? Why would He command and demand all people to do that? Listen. God is going to remind us and sinners who He is. We are going to have to bow our heads one day—people are—and recognize He is God. Do you know what it is going to do? It is going to glorify God the Father. That brings glory to Him.

The Bible says that Jesus here is talking to this fellow. He says here you are going to be standing on the outside knocking. There is no doubt he might have been talking in his mind about a Jewish wedding when the bride and the groom go into the house. The father of the groom would come over and shut the door. If you weren't there when the door was shut you did not get it.

Listen. I have something to say here that I want you to get. There is going to be a day that is coming that Jesus Christ is going to come. He is going to come and get His bride. He is going to come back to get you and me; the church. We are His bride. Do you know what He is going to do? He is going to take us back to Father's house. Aren't you glad that this thing doesn't stop at the grave? Aren't you glad that it doesn't stop here on planet earth, but He is going to take us back to Father's house. Do you know what there is going to be? There is going to be a wedding supper of the Lamb. There is going to be praise and glory given unto the God of heaven because of what He has done. There is going to be a lot of people that are going to be standing on the outside knocking and wanting in. Please let me in. It is not going to happen. If you are not ready when Jesus Christ comes in the clouds then you are not going to heaven. It doesn't matter how religious you have been. It doesn't matter what kind of position you have held. It doesn't matter about all those things. The only thing that is going to allow you to enter in the kingdom of heaven is by being born again. Nothing else.

One door. One way. One plan. Not one of many. Not one of a thousand. Not one of ten thousand. If you are going to go, you are going to go just like everybody else goes—one way. That is plain. Isn't it?

He says this.

Luke 13:25 When once the master of the house is risen up, and hath shut to the door, and ye begin to stand without, and to knock at the door, saying, Lord, Lord, open unto us; and he shall answer and say unto you, I know you not whence ye are:

The Bible says here that they begin to stand on the outside and knock. "Lord, Lord open to us." Get this. He shall answer and say "I don't know who you are." Look at what they say.

Luke 13:26 Then shall ye begin to say, We have eaten and drunk in thy presence, and thou hast taught in our streets.

The Lord says, "I don't know who you are. You guys are knocking. You guys want in but I don't know you. You are not part of my family." You have not been born into my family. I don't know who you are. You are not part of the marriage supper of the Lamb. You are not part of the church. I don't know who you are."

Luke 13:26 Then shall ye begin to say, We have eaten and drunk in thy presence, and thou hast taught in our streets.

In other words, Jesus says, "You guys are knocking. I have told you I don't know who you are. Now you guys are going to say this." He says here, "We have eaten and drunk in thy presence. Lord, don't you remember me? I was there when we had the fellowship dinner in the fellowship hall. We sang O How I Love Jesus. We sang What A Friend We Have in Jesus. Lord I was there at camp, when we were around the camp fire. You came. People sang and you blessed people. Lord I was there at Vacation Bible School when the altar was aligned with kids and adults being saved. I was there. Don't you remember me Lord? I was there. We have eaten and drunk in your presence. Lord you have to remember me."

Just because we have been in the fellowship hall when we are having fellowship, just because we were there when 10, 20, 30, 40 or whatever it was gets saved, just because we were at the camp fire at camp and God blessed and people sang and His glory came down in a great way; just because you were there doesn't guarantee you are going to heaven. Do you get that?

Luke 13:26 Then shall ye begin to say, We have eaten and drunk in thy presence, and thou hast taught in our streets.

"We were right there where you were at. Lord, you blessed the church. People sang. People testified. People shouted. People raised their hand. I was there when so and so got saved. We have been in your presence. Surely you know who I am."

That should make you think. We have eaten and drank in your presence. Get this.

Luke 13:26 Then shall ye begin to say, We have eaten and drunk in thy presence, and thou hast taught in our streets.

Lord, don't you remember when you walked down through the streets of Bethany, Capernaum, Chorazin, Bethsaida, or Nain; Lord don't you remember I was one of them standing there beside the road the day that You raised the little boy at Nain, I was there Lord. You were teaching and doing all of that. Don't you remember me? I was there. I saw what you did. You raised that boy from the dead. Lord, don't you remember. I remember Lord. I was there. I was following you. When you touched the lepers and you cleansed them. Lord, don't you remember me? I was there. I was in the crowd.

Do you know what some people are going to say? Lord, I was at Campbell Chapel or I was at the church down the road. Lord I was there when so and so got saved. Lord I was there when we were having revival and people were shouting and waving their

hands and things were just great. I was there. Don't you remember me Lord? I remember you teaching and preaching. I was there. Don't you remember me?

Luke 13:27 But he shall say, I tell you, I know you not whence ye are; depart from me, all ye workers of iniquity.

How do you add that up? How do you put that in perspective? Here it is very plain to me. Just because you saw Jesus raise a boy from the dead does not mean you are going to heaven. Just because you saw people lined up at the altar, and people getting saved and born again and you saw them get up from the altar and thank God I have been forgiven; that is no sign that you are going to heaven. Just because you have been here when Jan has testified and others have sung and testified and the Holy Ghost came in a great way and people shouted and praised God and His presence was in here where you could feel it; doesn't mean you are on your way to heaven.

The reason that these folks are not on their way to heaven is because they have never strived or agonized or went through the strait gate. To get through the strait gate do you know what you have to do? To get through the narrow way, when you read Matthew, chapter 7, strait is the gate, narrow is the way that leads into life, few there be that find it. Do you remember reading that? Do you know what you have to do to get through the strait gate when you read that in the original? It brings out this idea. To get through this gate, you can't carry any baggage. You have to take off the backpacks and all the other stuff that you are dragging with you. You can't get through this gate and carry all this other stuff.

Listen. You are not going to go to heaven carrying a backpack. You are not going to go to heaven carrying a backpack full of the world and its stuff. You can't get there. You can't get through the gate. it is too narrow. It is a straight and narrow way.

The Bible says this. Jesus said, "Hey guys, you are going to knock. You are going to tell me that you have heard me preach. We have seen you walk down the street in our town. We have seen you do all kinds of things. Lord, you have to remember me? That is what the enemy thinks. That is what the enemy wants us to think. That the Lord is going to accept because you have been involved with Christian activity or been involved with things that Christ is doing. He was doing this stuff. He was in their streets. He raised their dead. They were there. They saw it. They knew that. They ate and drank in His presence. What they probably ate and drank was stuff that He probably blessed and gave to them. They saw that. Just because we have seen God fill this place with His glory, just because we have been in the fellowship hall and ate and had great times of fellowship, just because we have been at camp or at Vacation Bible School, or some of the meetings that we had out here on the ground.

I was thinking about earlier today. One time we met down here in the field down here. Everybody put something on a piece of paper, a request that they had. Do you remember that? We had a firepit down there—we will do that again one day, Lord willing—everybody wrote on there a prayer request. I didn't have any idea what they

were. Nobody else did. They put that prayer request in the fire and it went up to God. God was there in a great way. Some of those prayer requests that were put into that fire, do you know what God has done? God has answered those prayers.

Listen. The prayer of Jabez is real. Amen! It is real. We forget that sometimes. We don't say it enough I don't think.

He says here, "Depart from me, ye that work iniquity. I never knew you."

Luke 13:28 There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of God, and you yourselves thrust out.

When you read Luke 16, turn over a few chapters, you read that story where the rich man dies and in hell he lifts up his eyes, being in torments. Do you know what he looks across the great gulf and sees? He sees Lazarus in Abraham's bosom. Jesus said here—get this—I never knew this until today. The word *weeping* here, when you read it in the original says, crying buckets of tears. Not just a few tears, weeping, crying buckets of tears.

The lake of fire isn't going to be a pretty place. You are not going to be rejoicing in the lake of fire. Your buddy, your husband, your wife, your dad, your mom, your children, your co-workers could be all around you, but I promise you something there isn't going to be rejoicing there. There is going to be weeping and gnashing of teeth. When you look across the great divide, the great gulf is there and you see Abraham, Isaac, and the prophets and maybe your family and different ones here in this story He is teaching us here to look across this great divide and see people that sat in the fellowship hall when you were there. They sat beside you at the church you went to. They were there when the altars were lined with people. Here you are weeping and grinding and gnashing your teeth; you look across the great gulf and you see people rejoicing. People—everybody knew Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. These people knew who Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob were. I would never that I know how things are going to be because I don't know. I know in this story, these people that Jesus Christ has rejected because they did not strive to enter in. they can look across this great gulf and see people they recognized in this story. I am not going to say it is going to be that way in heaven because I don't know. In this story, on this particular day, when Jesus was traveling to Jerusalem for the last time, they could look across and see Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

The Bible says they are going to come from the east, the west, the north and the south. The Bible says...

Luke 13:29 And they shall come from the east, and *from* the west, and from the north, and *from* the south, and shall sit down in the kingdom of God.

Luke 13:30 And, behold, there are last which shall be first, and there are first which shall be last.

Do you know what that means? God is calling people. God is knocking on people's hearts today. He is giving you an opportunity today to come and enter in at the strait gate that is narrow. You are going to have to leave this world all behind. All the stuff and all the things you are holding onto that you think is so important that is keeping you from coming in; you are going to have leave that on the outside. I promise you something, when you leave all of that stuff on the outside and come to Jesus Christ, you are going to find riches and wealth like you never have known.

Get this. When you come to Jesus Christ, you are going to be able to love your husband or your wife like you are really suppose to. You are going to be able to love your children. You have a relationship with your children. That is a whole lot better off today, like you are suppose to. When you go to work tomorrow, if you have a job; your attitude will be different. There might be people there that hates you, that despises you and maybe you haven't cared much about them. When Jesus Christ moves in you will treat them right. Even though they don't like you, even though they might be trying to destroy you; you will treat them right. Do you know why? It is because Jesus Christ has come into your life.

Folks listen. Don't lose the opportunity tonight to make things right with God. Wherever you are at, if you are in this building, if you are half way around the world, if you are on a mountainside somewhere, if you are driving down the road in the car, if you are driving a truck down the road...you may be in a fishing boat somewhere half way around the world; if Jesus Christ is speaking to you tonight, it may day where you are at, it may be evening where you are at, whatever time it is it would be a great time for you to come.
